• NEW VEHICLES

As of 31 January 2015, vehicles built from 1 January 1949 will require a full certificate of roadworthiness to apply for the club permit scheme.

Vehicle safety checks for permit issue can be carried out by our safety scrutineers by request. Because these checks are to be done by trading mechanical repair businesses, for legal reasons a fee will be charged (and returned to club funds) and the check will need to be booked in as any other job.

• PERMIT RENEWAL

Upon renewal, please photocopy your renewal form for club records and ensure the club has hard copy photographs of your vehicle. Required date stamped photos are:

- front
- rear
- driving position (side on, door open)
- driver side
- passenger side
- body and engine number stampings and plates

Permit registration renewals are to be signed by club signatories at club meetings only. Please do not approach them at their workplace or home, except in a pre-arranged emergency situation.

- Please remember that club permit holders must remain financial members of the club at all times as required by VicRoads. As such, yearly membership fees need to be received no later than June 30.

We crossed the highway and out the Seven Mile Road to North Canal Road and back to Yarragon, then out the Little Moe River Road and then down the Darnum road to our club shed for afternoon tea. We then proceeded via Cloverlea and back to the start arriving at approx. 4pm - 7 hours and 97km on the tractors. We were all a little weary when we got back, none of the Fergys failed to proceed however the Nuffield had to be tow started at lunch and left running the rest of the day due to a starter motor issue (it broke off).

We all had a thoroughly enjoyable day and would like to thank the Fergy club for the invite.

“Need for Feed” Hay Run

Saturday 26 January

On Saturday 26 January, after having loaded the donated 27 bales of hay from the Club Shed and 21 bales from Andrew and Bridgette McDonald on Friday, we headed with eight other trucks, some utes and trailers, to Traralgon. There we stopped for brunch supplied by Traralgon Lions and were given the contacts and addresses of where our loads were going.

Our load and another load totalling 80 bales went to a drop off farm at Iguana Creek, approx. half way to Dargo. We delivered hay and care packages and hampers to be distributed to those who need.

The people we talked to had sold all their cattle except a total of 80, including mothers and calves. As we arrived and while we were unloading the cattle were standing at the fence hoping for some hay. Paddocks are bare and brown, even the weeds weren't growing. They were going into their third year of drought.

Everyone camped at the Sale Showgrounds, with tea provided by the Sale Lions Club, spending the evening learning where other loads went and how the farmers were coping.

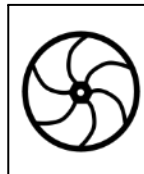
