Minutes of General Monthly Meeting at Clubrooms 8th July 2021, 7.30pm

President Doug opened the meeting, welcomed those in attendance, and called for apologies.

Apologies were recorded on the attendance sheet on a motion of Helen Baker/Colin Silsbury. Crd.

Arising Ground approval from Council for the 2021 Spring Rally held over to General Business.

Correspondence Secretary Daryl tabled the inwards Correspondence and was accepted on the **Motion** of D Whateley/L Whateley. **Carried.**

Treasurer Neil tabled a financial report and advised subs are continuing to be received, Insurance cards have been received and hand out to those in attendance. **Motion** by N Buckley/L Pellow that the report be accepted **Carried.**

General Business Daryl gave a report on behalf of the rally committee. The committee advises that we have received subjective approval for the grounds, having supplied to council a risk assessment and covid plan. Certificate of currency (recognizing ERC) received tonight, and Helen will deliver to council. A QR code has been obtained. Posters have been acquired and Flyers have been posted out. P&A have advised that they don't think they will be able to cater as their numbers are down. We have requested from them the usual amenities and are assuming that we have them (to be followed up).

We are still hoping to hold the rally, but we are bound by whatever covid rules apply at any given time. We will have a Rally Meeting Thursday 19th August and possibly another before the end of August.

Some discussion then took place as to the possibility of the need for cancellation, but as football is still operating (and we have a smaller crowd) I feel we will be right unless harsher restrictions come into force. Border issues may impact on us but should only impact the number of exhibits. AND if we have a smaller rally – so be it. IF we must cancel – so be it. We just hope the Gods have forgiving laps.

Pat asked about easier access for the less able people and the executive have taken this on board and will arrange something. Treasurer Neil has arranged for electricians to repair the instant water heater and investigate the heaters cutting out.

President Doug welcomed two new members in Christian Spicer and Craig Russell and recognized Neville Sleeman visiting from Jerilderie. He then thanked all for attending and closed the meeting at 8.10PM.
