Gisborne Rally's Steam display features our Fowler Road Roller and the refurbished 1923 13HP Ruston Hornsby Portable Steam Engine running the McKenzie family's Rock Crusher. The Perry Cane Locomotive will be in steam, travelling up and down on its now extended demonstration track.

Again we will be holding our ever popular Tractor Pull with a new loading ramp for better loading and unloading. Our new Engine Bays will be ready to accommodate our Club's displays and all our visitors who come to share with us.

The 7¼" Mini Train will be running to provide rides for children (and adults!). The Model Train Shed will also be running. An Animal farm and Camel Rides are other attractions that the children love as well.

As usual there will be a display of Veteran, Vintage and Classic Cars and Trucks.

Rally Rules for Exhibitors

All Exhibitors

1. With the exception of certain exhibits, vehicular traffic is not permitted inside the Rally Ground between 9am and 3pm on Sunday May 17
2. Entry to the Grounds for Exhibitors on Sunday May 17 is from 7.30am to 9am via the Main Gate which will be locked at 9am. If you need to leave early then you need to park outside before 9am.
3. All vehicles that are not being displayed are to be parked in the Exhibitors' Parking Area in the Compound or at the Truck Parking Area at the bottom of the Car Park opposite the loading ramp.
4. All Exhibitors must fill in a Registration Form either by mail in advance or at the Registraion Tent on checking into the Grounds. The Registration Tent is opposite the Engines Display just inside the Main Entry.
5. All Exhibitors **must not start packing up before 3PM** at the end of the Rally. Departure should be finished by 5.30pm.
6. It is the responsibility of all Exhibitors to take care of their own displays and equipment during the day as the Society does not take any responsibility for loss or damage to your equipment on display.

Oil and Petrol Engine Exhibitors

1. No-one except Club Members and operators of machinery is allowed in the Stationary Engine fenced enclosure while machinery is running. NMHA Rules apply.
2. All operators must be over the age of 18 years and Junior Members must be accompanied by an adult Club Member at all times while equipment is running.
3. Engines shall be placed in the Stationary Engine enclosure with flywheels running PARRALLEL to the fence and at least 1 metre from the fence.

Vintage tractors and other moving equipment (Refer Also to NHMA Guidelines)

1. Only one person is to be on a mobile tractor at any one time
2. Maximum speed limit for all moving equipment is 5km/h while in the Grounds of the Rally
3. All drivers are to follow the Organisers' and Marshals' directions at all times while on the Rally Grounds.
4. All tractors and other moving equipment are to be in a safe working condition and have appropriate Registration or current Work Safe tickets (current Boiler Certificate etc).

Children's Activities And Rides

1. All must have a current Working With Children Card with them while working with children's activities.
2. All rides and exhibitions must have their own Public Liability Insurance and General Insurance as the Society takes no responsibility for any incidents involving children on their exhibits, rides, etc.
