Look at the ring shaped cavity. In this will be placed a hot forged ring that shrinks and hold the two flywheel half together.

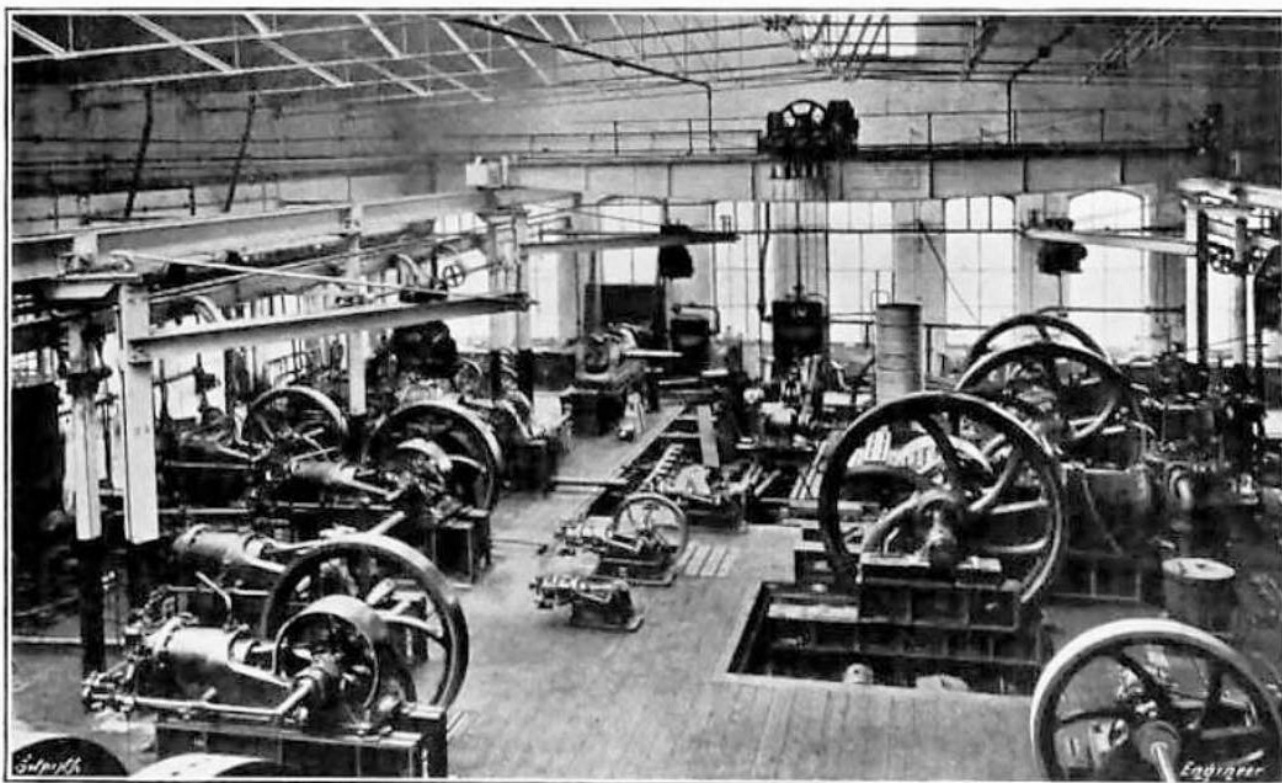


Fig. 2—TESTING DEPARTMENT

We started up 2 or 3 more times, John & Daniel managed to source some parts they needed for a tractor they are restoring, and I got a couple leads on some tractors that might become available.

It was a great day, weather was perfect for showing, warm, overcast, cool breeze most of the day, there was people everywhere and there was heaps to keep everyone occupied for a day.

Packing up, loading and home was uneventful, and much to Nicky's amazement, I was home all done by 8pm.

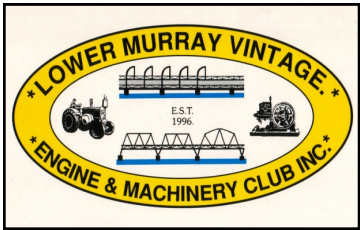
